Dear Ms. Jablow:

This responds to your request that the Office of Government Ethics (“OGE”) investigate concerns of ethical violations by Claudia Lujan, Deputy Chief for Strategic School Planning and Enrollment.

Please be advised that OGE’s jurisdiction is limited to provisions in the Board of Ethics & Government Accountability Establishment and Comprehensive Ethics Reform Amendment Act of 2011 (“Ethics Act”), effective April 27, 2012 (D.C. Law 19-124; D.C. Official Code § 1-1161.01 (2014 Supp.)). We examined your complaint, but at this time there is insufficient evidence of a violation of the Code of Conduct.

Please note that this matter was never made public and therefore remains in that status under the Ethics Act and the rules of this Office.
