To support smart and safe decision-making to reopen the schools in the fall, the Deputy Mayor for Education is conducting a short survey to understand your preferences for how students will take part in learning during school year 2020-21. The options highlighted in this survey are not definite – they are choices that are being considered as the city moves forward.

The survey takes about 15 minutes to complete and your responses are anonymous. Please complete this survey considering the needs of all children in your family. Thank you for taking the time to share your opinion.

- **Alternating days:** In-person instruction in the school building every other day and home engaged in remote/online learning on out of school days
- **Two (2) days of back to back in-person instruction and three (3) days at home each week:** In-person instruction in the school building for two (2) days in a row and then at home doing remote/online learning for rest of week
- **One (1) week in-person instruction and one (1) week remote/online instruction at home:** In-person instruction in the school building for ~ one (1) week and then at home for remote/online learning for ~one (1) week
- **Two (2) weeks in-person instruction and two (2) weeks remote/online instruction at home:** In-person instruction in the school building for ~two (2) consecutive weeks and then remote/online learning for ~ two (2) consecutive weeks

Two (2) days of back to back in-person instruction and three (3) days at home each week

One (1) week in-person instruction and one (1) week remote/online instruction at home
