Exhibit II: Random Selection Process

The Friendship Public Charter School guidelines for enrollment have been determined based on the open-enrollment requirements stated in the D.C. School Reform Act §31-1802.06. If a campus receives more COMPLETE enrollment forms than there are slots available for a particular grade level by the enrollment deadline, a lottery will occur. Below is a brief description of the Friendship PCS lottery guidelines.

1. Parents are notified that a lottery will occur and extended an invitation to attend that includes the date and location of the drawing.
2. The lottery is held within TWO WEEKS after the enrollment deadline.
3. A separate lottery is conducted for each grade level and the applicable campus that has received more complete enrollment forms than slots available.
4. All names of students with COMPLETE enrollment forms will be entered into the lottery.
5. Names will be drawn in a number equal to the number of slots available. Unselected names will be placed on a waiting list in order of the date of enrollment form submission.
6. Parents of students whose names are selected during a random lottery drawing will be notified within 2 days of the lottery that their child(ren) has been selected in the lottery. Parents are given no more than 2 days to respond that they will/will not enroll child(ren).
7. If the parent DOES NOT send notification that s/he will enroll student within 48 hours, the campus may select the first student listed on the waiting list in accordance with the waiting list requirements.
