PALC Members must be:

- DC resident
 - (a) current parent of a DC public charter school student or
 - (b) graduate of a public charter school
- At least 18 years old
- Two year-term (Terms begin in September)

Members cannot be:

- A DC elected official (e.g., ANC, State Board of Education Representative)
- An employee of a public charter school or charter advocacy/support organization
- A charter school board chair or trustee/member
- A member of the "working press"
- A multimedia journalist, full-time blogger or blog editor
