Next year, the Office of the State Superintendent of Education will open the Advanced Technical Center, or ATC, where you can take classes in cybersecurity, general nursing and health information technology. If you will be in the 9th, 10th or 11th grades this fall, you are eligible to enroll at the ATC!

At the ATC, you can earn early college credit and industry credentials that can help jumpstart your future career. Ask your counselor how to apply or sign up here for more information.

How does it work?

- ATC courses **fit into your class schedule** during either the first or last periods of the day. You will travel to Trinity Washington University, where classes are held.
- Classes are **five days a week**.
- The ATC offers **two sessions a day** so you can choose the option that works best for your schedule -- morning (8:25-9:50 a.m.) or afternoon (2:40-3 p.m.).
- ATC programs consist of **four courses**. You should plan to finish the entire program.
